Dear Mr. Daly,

I am appealing to you directly to become involved with a very serious matter involving Focus and fellow ministry, Growing Families International. Enclosed, you will find two previous letters that were sent to Focus to give you some perspective on the issues. I am appealing because I am about to launch a website with content that will expose Focus in a negative light. Certainly, this is something that neither of us wants, but from my perspective, has become necessary.

I can assure you that the issue is not just academic, or a matter of “opinion.” Focus has clearly violated Christian relationship principles set out in God’s Word when it posted its position statement on GFI. This needs to be addressed by Focus in a substantive manner. There are also many fine Christian families who have stood with your ministry efforts, but are so discouraged with Focus’ position on the Ezzos and the GFI ministry that they have chosen withdraw their charitable donations to Focus. My family is included in that number. I cannot in good conscience support Focus when they continue to blatantly misstate facts, misrepresent a fellow ministry and refuse to be held accountable for clear error.

Below, is a copy of the information that will be posted on the website. I am not an official representative for GFI, only one who has been positively impacted by the ministry and I have taught GFI classes for over ten years. I do think I have the biblical authority to challenge Focus on its position statement and I hope you will plan to contact me for further discussion.
